Walk in the footsteps of the Spanish Fort "Fort Don Carlos" (1767-1780) located on the south-side of the mouth of the Missouri River. It was officially known as Fort Don Carlos el Senor Principe de Asturias, and it was an 80-foot square palisade with four bastions.
